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MEASURING GUIDE

1. CEILING HEIGHT

- * Measure from the floor to ceiling. (Note any obstructions such as beams or soffits.)
- * If your ceiling is vaulted, measure from the floor to the lowest point in the ceiling.
- * If you have a soffit, provide its exact footprint and dimensions (width, height, & depth) on the layout. Include from where the soffit begins to where it ends. If you plan to remove the soffit, measure the ceiling height without the soffit.

2. WALL MEASUREMENTS

- * Starting with the left most wall of the kitchen, measure each wall clockwise until you reach the last wall. (Take note of any obstructions such as windows, doors, pass-through, soffits, etc.)

3. CENTERLINE MEASUREMENTS

- * Note centerline of the items below measuring from the closest corner wall.
- * Center of hot, cold, and drain pipes for the sink (check to see if the drain pipe originates from another wall)
- * Center of refrigerator water line & electrical outlet
- * Center of gas line & outlet
- * Center of hood exhaust opening & outlet

4. WINDOWS, DOORS, & OPENINGS

- * Take dimensions of all windows, doors, and openings from:
 - * Corner wall to outside casing
 - * Outside casing to outside casing



- A: Ceiling Height
 - B: Wall #1
 - C: Wall #2
 - D: Wall #3
 - E: Window width outside casing-to-casing
 - F: Window height outside casing-to-casing
 - G: Top of window casing to ceiling
 - H: Corner wall to outside window casing
 - I: Door width outside casing to outside casing
 - J: Corner wall to door outside casing
 - K: Corner wall to hot, cold, & drain pipe
 - L: Corner wall to hood exhaust opening
